Inspired by design groups of Egyptian coastal environment achieve the aesthetic aspect of the upholstery fabric

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Abstract:

The design process stems from the artist's interaction with their environment. The artist interacts with the environment and draws inspiration from its design elements, based on the subject they wish to express. Egypt is blessed with diverse and varied environments. This diversity and variation in climate and weather have led to differences in environmental systems. Among these systems is the coastal ecosystem that extends across the coasts of the Red Sea and the Mediterranean. Therefore, many design elements expressing the coastal environment (marine organisms, fish, and coral reefs) have been inspired." This research explains the extent to which design elements can be reformulated to create designs used as furnishing fabrics. This is done to revive the heritage of the Egyptian coastal environment, making it appear in a unique way. These designs were executed using the double weave technique on a Jacquard machine. Six designs were created, and the best four were selected based on a questionnaire presented to (45) expert judges specializing in the textile industry from within and outside the university. The results showed that the best design was design No. 2, as it is balanced and harmonious, and there is a connection between all the elements used in it. Also, there is a balance between the mass and space within the design, in addition to its harmonious colors that are distributed in a creative way. Design No. (1) Followed closely, where the water droplet was integrated as if it were the movement of the wave, and the inspiration from the dolphin's movement led to a harmony of design elements. Design (3) recorded the lowest results due to the lack of connection between the design elements within it."

Research problem; How can the cultures and elements of the Egyptian coastal environment be utilized to achieve an artistic vision for designing upholstery fabrics inspired by coastal environmental elements? **Research aims:** 1- The research aims to explore the nature of the Egyptian coastal environment as one of the traditional Egyptian art forms, highlighting its simplicity and elegance. 2- It seeks to emphasize the national identity of our heritage (the coastal environment) without distorting shapes and details, with the goal of creating innovative artistic works used for upholstery fabrics. 3- The research attempts to enhance public taste and overcome the materialistic tendencies of the modern era, which threaten the spiritual heritage of the Egyptian people, by designing artistic patterns for upholstery fabrics that reflect Egypt's rich cultural heritage **Importance of research**: 1- Shedding light on the concept of the coastal environment in Egypt through its units and environmental elements and utilizing them in designs that can be implemented and used as upholstery fabrics. 2- Achieving a new artistic vision of heritage and benefiting from the treatments and solutions embedded in the rich Egyptian coastal environment

Hypothesis: 1- The elements and components of the Egyptian coastal environment can be utilized in innovative artistic works suitable for upholstery fabrics. 2- Studying various patterns and illustrations inspired by the Egyptian coastal environment

Research methodology: The research is based on the analytical-experimental approach.

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
